Terms & Conditions

1. FIFA 21 E-Tournament – Play for Pride is only open to all residing in Singapore only. There is no age limit to join.
2. If the participants are aged under 18 years old, the Organiser assumes that a parent or guardian has given their consent to them entering the tournament and accepting these rules. Once they are selected to be in the Quarter Finals, they are required to submit the completed parental consent and acknowledge form.
3. Employees, officers, directors, agents and representatives of the Organiser, or any of its affiliated companies, are not eligible to enter the tournament. The Organiser reserves the right not to award a prize (and to select an alternative Winner) if the Organizer is aware or has reasonable grounds to believe that a Winner is not eligible.
4. The tournament consists of ONLY English categories.
5. Contestants can enter their participation for the tournament during the recruitment period from 10th September 2020 to 8th October 2020 via our website only. Single entries are accepted only.
6. The Organiser has the right at any time to require proof of identity and/or eligibility. Failure to provide such proof within a reasonable time shall, at the discretion of the Organiser, result in disqualification from the tournament. All personal details and information requested by and supplied to the Organiser by each contestant must be truthful, accurate and in no way misleading. The Organiser reserves the right to disqualify any contestant from the tournament or audition process in its sole discretion, should the contestant at any stage supply untruthful, inaccurate or misleading personal details and/or information.
7. It is a condition of entry and participation in the tournament that each contestant:
 - a. Confirms and undertakes that he/she shall not drop out of any stage of the tournament. In the event that the Organiser deems it necessary to re-schedule any part of the tournament, the contestant in question agrees to perform compete again.
 - b. Contestants shall participate in any promotional and/or publicity activities as may be required by the Organiser, including without limitation, photoshoots, interviews, press conferences which does not interfere with the production schedules.
8. Contestants who fail to attend briefings on time will be disqualified from the Competition.
 - a. The Organiser reserves the right to bar any contestant from appearing in the tournament on the grounds of undesirable conduct and/or appearance.
 - b. The Organiser reserves the right to publish/use any photographs or videos taken of the contestants during the tournament and to use the name and likeness of any contestant, including friends, family or any other individual accompanying the contestants.

9. Each contestant consents and agrees to the Organiser recording his/ her performance(s) at all stages of the tournament, including any live broadcast(s), whether such recording be audio, audio-visual or in the form of photographs and further acknowledges that the Organiser has the right to edit, telecast or choose not to telecast any such recording.
10. By taking part in the tournament, the contestants each and all irrevocably give all consents and waivers necessary for the Organiser to record and use their performances in any manner, for any purpose (commercial or otherwise) and in any part of the world as the Organiser deems fit. The contestants agree that the Organiser may use any recording made by the Organiser, including but not limited to, audio recordings, visual recordings, and photographs, for the promotions and publicity of the Competition.
11. All contestants shall be responsible for their own transportation, food and drinks or lodging required by them during or in connection with the tournament and no reimbursement may be sought from the organiser.
12. Obtaining time off work and / or study or related activities to participate in the tournament and/or a prize will be the sole and absolute responsibility of each contestant.
13. The Organiser shall not be liable to the contestants or to their legal representatives for any loss, damage or injury to their person or property during or in connection with the tournament.
14. The stages of the competition will be streamed LIVE (and not limited to Facebook and YouTube):
 - a. Round of 32 – 17 and 18 October 2020 (2pm to 6pm)
 - b. Round of 16 – 24 October 2020 (2pm to 6pm)
 - c. Quarter Finals – 25 October 2020 (2pm)
 - d. Semi Finals – 25 October 2020 (3pm)
 - e. 3rd and 4th finals - 25 October 2020 (5pm)
 - f. Finals – 25 October 2020 (5pm)
15. The Organiser reserves the right to cancel, drop, and restructure any part of the tournament for whatever reason, without incurring any liability to the contestants and without having to provide any reasons.
16. For the audition, Contestants are to showcase their creativity in bringing out their best but not limited to trash talking, bullying and intimidating.
17. The score at the end of the game is final and no inquiries or appeals, verbal or written, will be entertained.
18. The Organiser reserves the right to add, delete and/or alter the list of prizes offered for this Competition.
19. The Organiser has the sole discretion to decide when or whether to broadcast part of all of the tournament, postpone or change the timing of any such broadcast without incurring any liability to the contestants.

20. Contestants shall not at any time (whether during or after the tournament) make any personal appearance, give any interview or allow publication in any media (be it online, print, visual or audio) in any capacity in relation to the tournament, nor disclose any information or details whatsoever concerning the tournament, other finalists and participants, prize winners, the Organiser or its related companies, officers, licensees and/or agents without the prior written consent and approval of the Organiser. Without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing, contestants shall not make any disparaging remarks or any comments about the tournament or the Organiser which may adversely affect the reputation of the tournament or the Organiser.
21. The Finalists and Winner of the tournament may be required to commit to the recording and publicity and promotion campaign for the promotion of certain products/services.
22. The Quarter Finalists shall not enter any other FIFA e-tournament during the tenure of this competition.
23. All Contestants must abide by the applicable terms and conditions as stated in English only. Only the English version of these terms and conditions shall prevail and apply to all the Contestants: any translation thereof into other language(s) is for the convenience of the Contestants only. Noncompliance with or breach of the applicable terms and conditions shall immediately disqualify the Contestants from further participation in the tournament and any prizes won shall be forfeited.
24. These terms and conditions may from time to time be made or amended by the Organiser. All such rules shall be solely interpreted by the Organiser and the Organiser's interpretation shall be final at all times
25. Contestants agree that their personal data may be used by GNV AVLFX and its designated representatives or business partners to provide goods and services to the contestants and matters ancillary thereto:
 - a. To verify and process payment.
 - b. For verification and record of the contestants' personal particulars including comparing it with information from other sources and using the information to communicate with the contestants.
 - c. For research and analysis, including surveys and polls.
 - d. For publicity and promotional purpose.
 - e. To contact the contestants for future casting opportunities
 - f. To send the contestants notices, information, promotions and updates including marketing and advertising materials in relation GNV AVLFX's goods and services and those of third party organizations selected by GNV AVLFX.
 - g. To comply with any request from any third party or any order of court or directive from authorities investigating any alleged offence or misconduct or for the purposes of taking legal action against the participants
